

Reporting in ADAM

Once students/candidates have begun submitting their tests, post-testing activities can begin.

ADAM provides several reporting features for accessing student results. These include the:

- 1) Performance Dashboard,
- 2) Results Explorer, and
- 3) Student Dashboard.

Access ADAM via LaunchPad

Login to LaunchPad

1. In your web browser, navigate to <https://launchpad.pearson.com/accountselect/act>

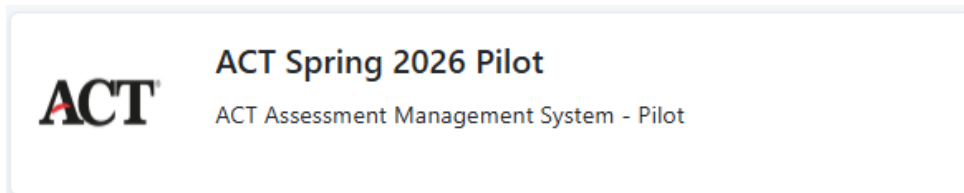
Select your school district, then click the “Continue to Sign In” button.



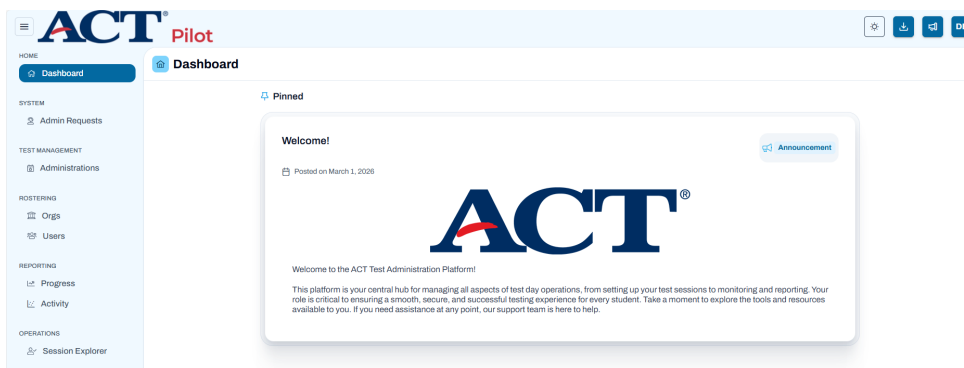
2. As a District/Site Test Coordinator user, enter the Username and Password for your LaunchPad account and click the 'Sign in' button.

The ADAM Dashboard for the ACT Spring 2026 Pilot will appear.

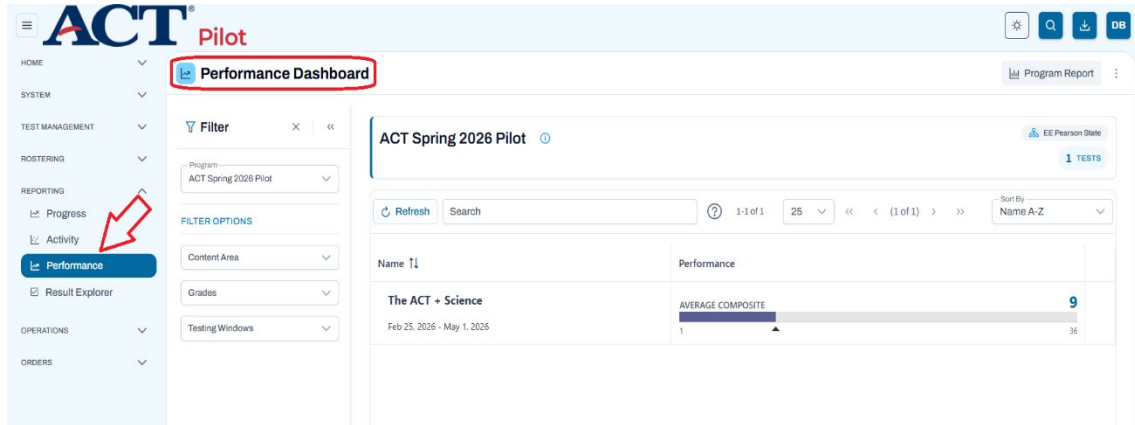


All of the following Reporting topics will assume the District/Site Test Coordinator is able to successfully login to ADAM via LaunchPad.

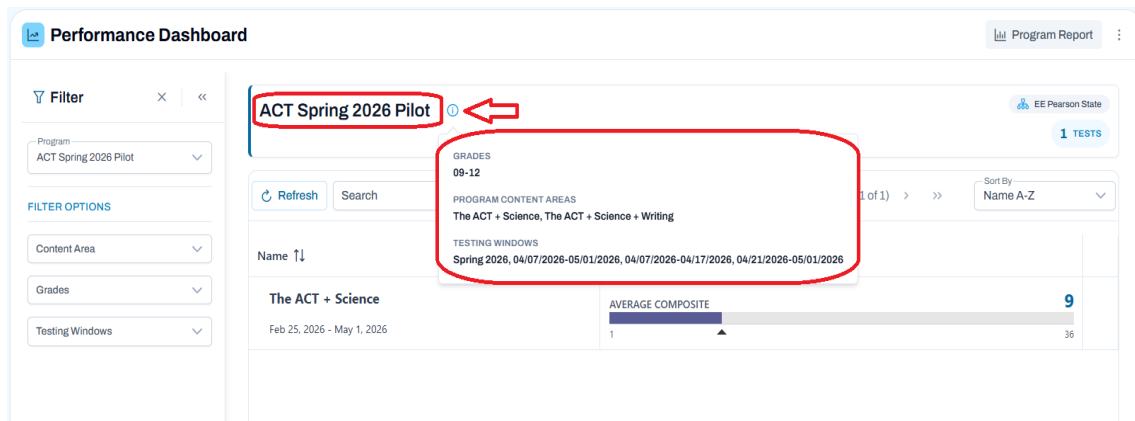


Performance Dashboard

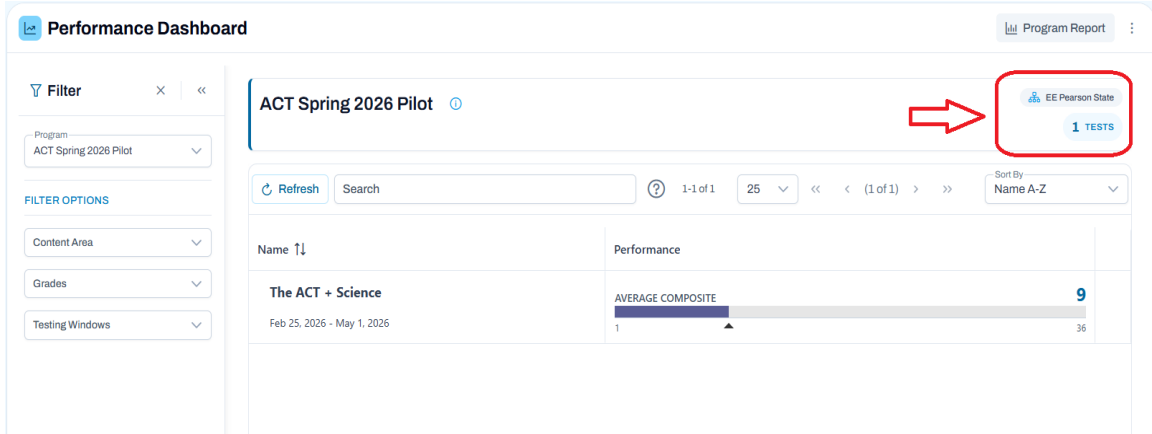
1. On the ADAM user dashboard page, click 'Performance' in the left navigation menu. The Performance Dashboard screen will appear showing all applicable tests.



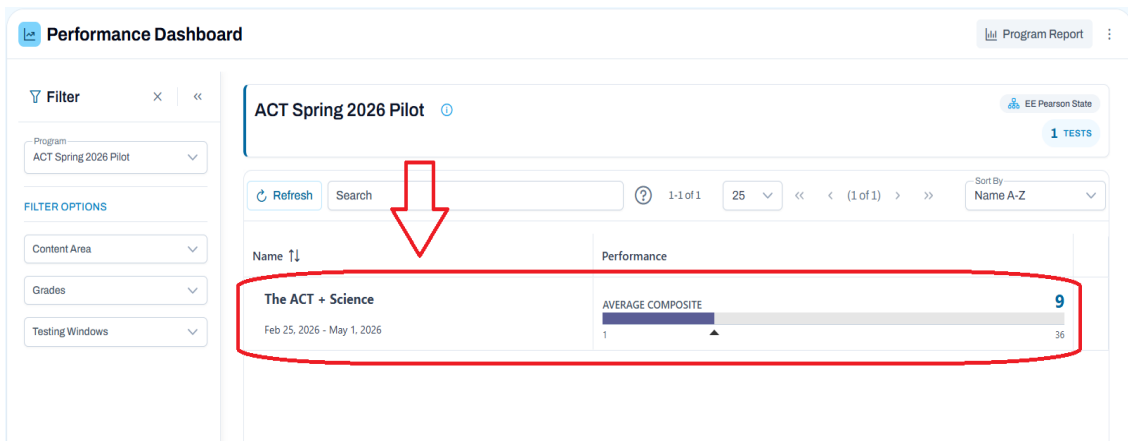
2. The Testing Program is displayed at the top of the page. In this example, the Program is named “**ACT Spring 2026 Pilot.**” Click the informational button next to the program name to view information related to the program – grades, content areas, and testing windows.



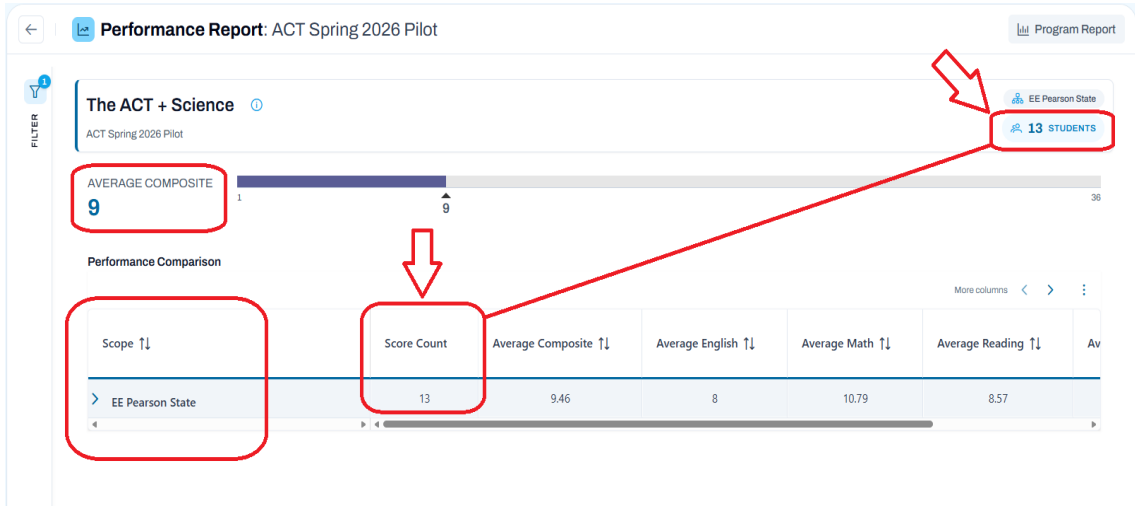
- On the right side of the page, the organization scope and total number of tests included in the dashboard reporting is displayed. In this example, the organization scope is set to “EE Pearson State” with one test (The ACT + Science) included in the dashboard reporting.



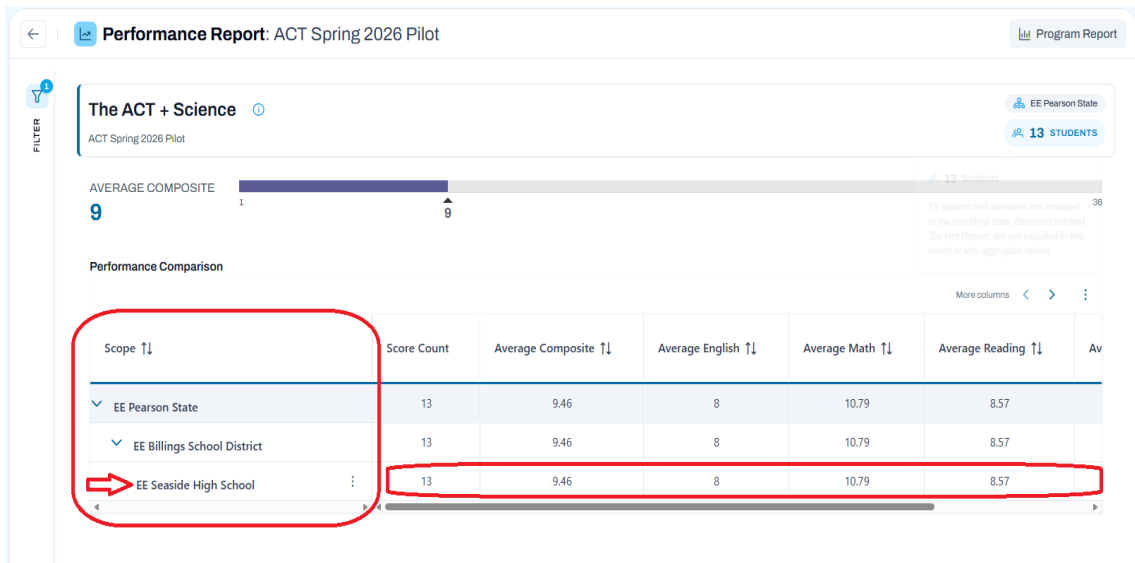
- The tests included in the Program (ACT Spring 2026 Pilot) are listed at the bottom of the page. In this example, one test (“The ACT + Science”) is reported along with the average composite score (e.g. “9”) for that test. Also, the range of available test scores is indicated below the performance bar (e.g. 1-36). The active testing window for the test administration is shown below the test name (e.g. Feb 25, 2026 – May 1, 2026).



- Click on the test name to display more details related to the test (The ACT + Science). In this example, we have test results compiled for 13 students across the “EE Pearson State” organization scope. These 13 students achieved an average composite score of “9” as indicated on the performance bar.



Click on the arrows next to the organization name to drill-down to a lower level in the organization hierarchy. In this example, we display test results at the school level (e.g. EE Seaside High School).



The “Performance Comparison” table displays results across all components of the test: English, Math, Reading, and Science. In addition, the Composite score is shown (far left) along with the Average STEM score (far right).

If necessary, use the Filter pane on the left to narrow the scope of the results reported. In this example, we use one of the STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC FILTERS (Student Grade) to limit the scope to the five (5) students in Grade 10 at EE Seaside High School. Use the “Refresh” button to update the table after setting the filter.

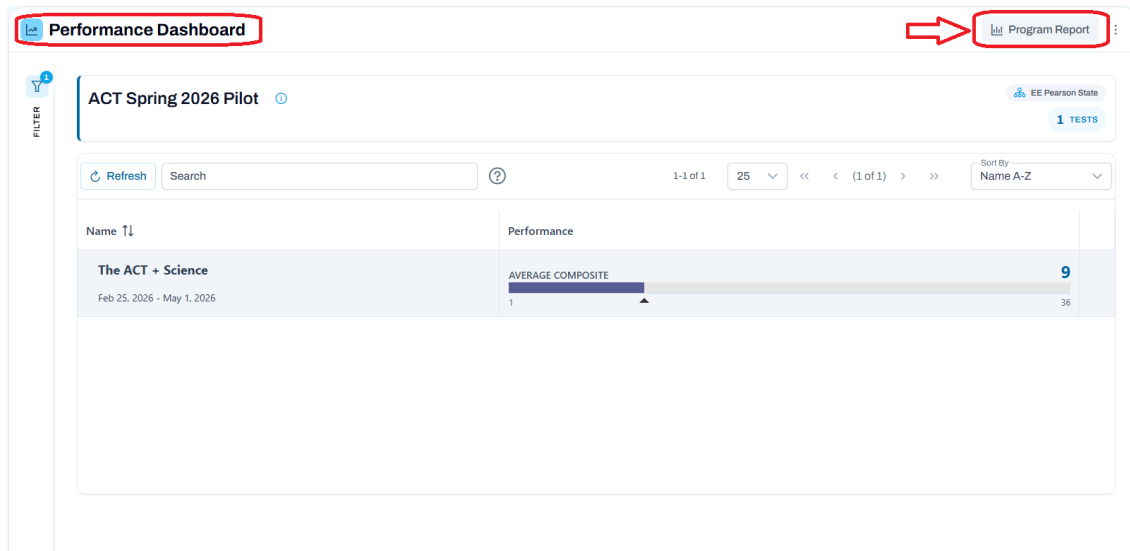

- To access the Program Report, click on the “Program Report” button in the upper right corner of the Performance Dashboard.



The Program Report will be displayed showing average scores for all program content areas.



The Program Report can be filtered by specifying any combination of:

i) Test Grades

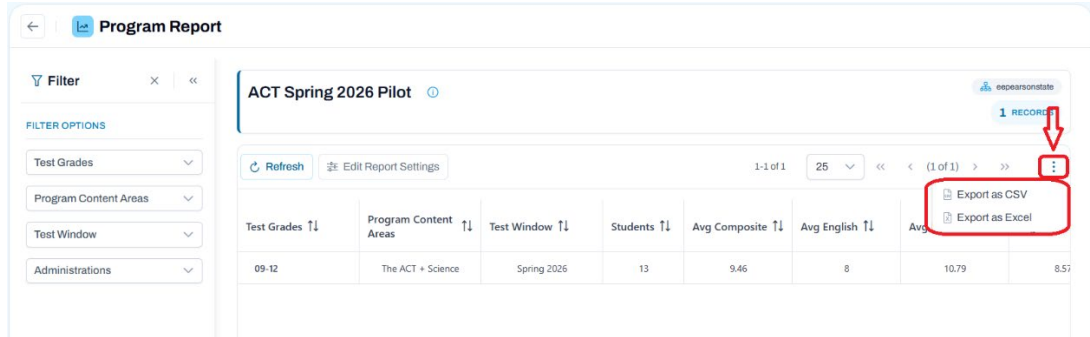
ii) Program Content Areas

iii) Test Window

iv) ...and Administrations



8. There are two options for exporting the Program Report data:
- i) Export as CSV file, or
 - ii) Export as Excel file.




9. Finally, there is an option available to customize the Program Report by editing the report settings. Click the “Edit Report Settings” button.



This will display the Program Report Settings page where you can:

- i) Organize the report by order of columns (drag the columns to reorder)
- ii) Add columns (e.g. Student Grade, Gender)
- iii) Set persistent Report Filters (same options as the dynamic filter)
- iv) Add Student Demographic Filters (e.g. Student Grade, Gender)

Once all desired report settings are specified, click the “Save Settings” button in the lower right corner of the page.



Result Explorer

The Result Explorer reporting function allows you to view test results for all students or a filtered list of students. The Result Explorer window displays each student's name and student ID, the school reporting the results, the name of the test (e.g., The ACT + Science, Workplace Documentation, etc.), and the date on which the test was submitted.

For districts administering The ACT, Result Explorer also displays composite and individual test scores for each student depending upon the specific version of The ACT administered (The ACT, The ACT + Science, The ACT + Science and Writing, etc.).

- Composite score – the overall composite for the version of The ACT
- English score
- Math score
- Reading score
- Science score (if administered)
- STEM score (if administered)
- Writing score (if administered)
- ELA score (if administered)

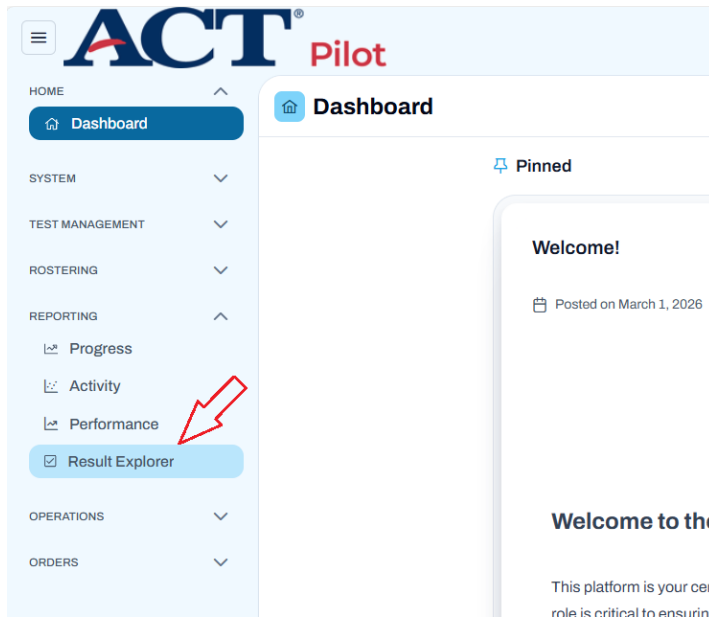
For districts administering the WorkKeys suite of assessments, Result Explorer displays the student scale score for the specified test and the student performance level.

The Result Explorer reporting function also allows you to export data and download it in .CSV format, allowing additional processing and data analysis in your preferred tools.

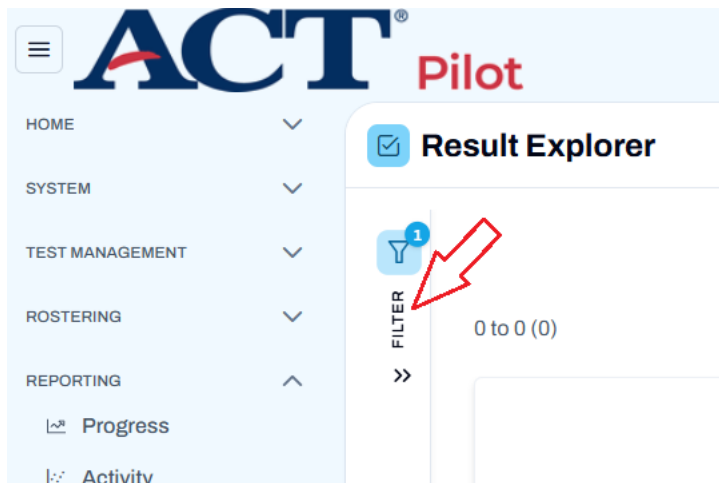


To view student test results in Result Explorer:


1. On the ADAM user dashboard page, click to expand the Reporting section in the left navigation menu, then click Result Explorer.



2. If necessary, click the Filter area on the left side of the screen to expand the filter selection area.



The filter selection area will appear.

3. Select the criteria by which you would like to filter the results data.
 - Program – the specific testing program for which you would like to view results. For district users participating in the Spring district pilot, this will include “ACT Spring 2026 Pilot” (for The ACT administrations) or WorkKeys Spring 2026 Pilot” (for WorkKeys administrations).
 - Test – use this filter to see results only for a specific test. The available values are based on the program selected. For example, if you are administering The ACT + Science and The ACT + Science and Writing, you can use the Test filter to view results for one or the other. If you are administering the WorkKeys suite of tests, you can use the Test filter to view results for only Workplace Documents, only Applied Math, etc..
 - Organization – for district level users, you can choose to view results for only a selected school within your district.



- Advanced filters – You can also choose to view results filtered by demographic values of test grades (the grades being tested), student grade (the students’ current grade), or gender.

4. When you have selected your desired filtering values, click the Search button at the bottom of the filter selection area to display the results.



5. Result Explorer will display the student results based on your filtering criteria. The tool provides several ways to navigate the results:

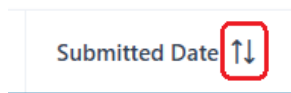

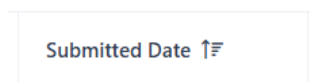

- Click any column name with an up and down arrow icon next to it to sort the results records by that column.



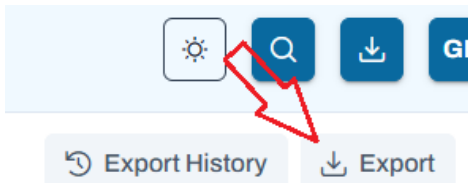
The icon next to the sorted column name will change to indicate the order of the sort (ascending/descending / newest/oldest, etc.). Click the name again to reverse the sort order.



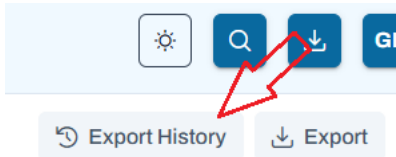
- To add any recently submitted results to the view, click the Refresh button in the upper right corner of the page.



- If you would like to download data from Result Explorer for use in another program, click the Export button in the upper right corner of the screen. The data will automatically create a new export in your Export History.



- Click the Export History button in the upper right corner of the screen to view your exports.



- In the Export History window, find your export and ensure its status is "Completed." Then, click the download button next to the export name to download a .CSV file with the results data. The file will automatically be saved to the download save location configured on your computer or network (typically the default Downloads directory on a Windows computer).

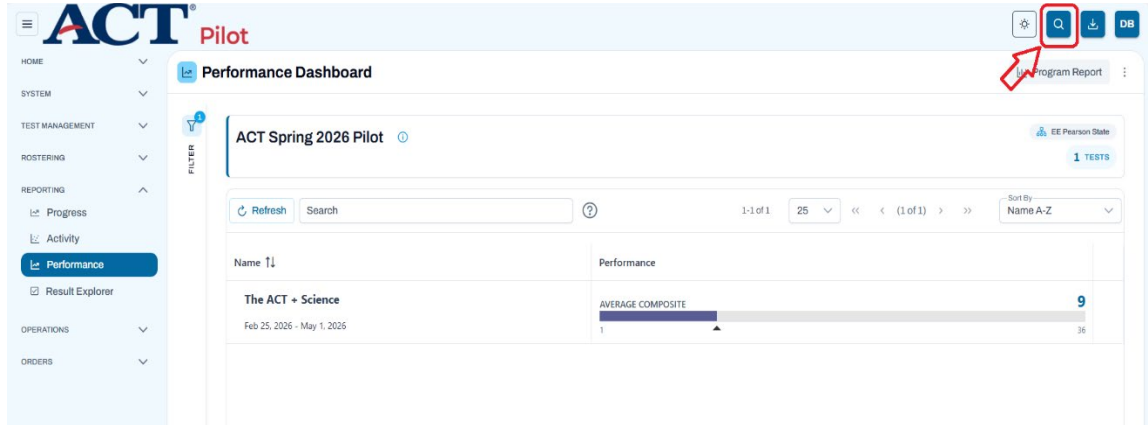

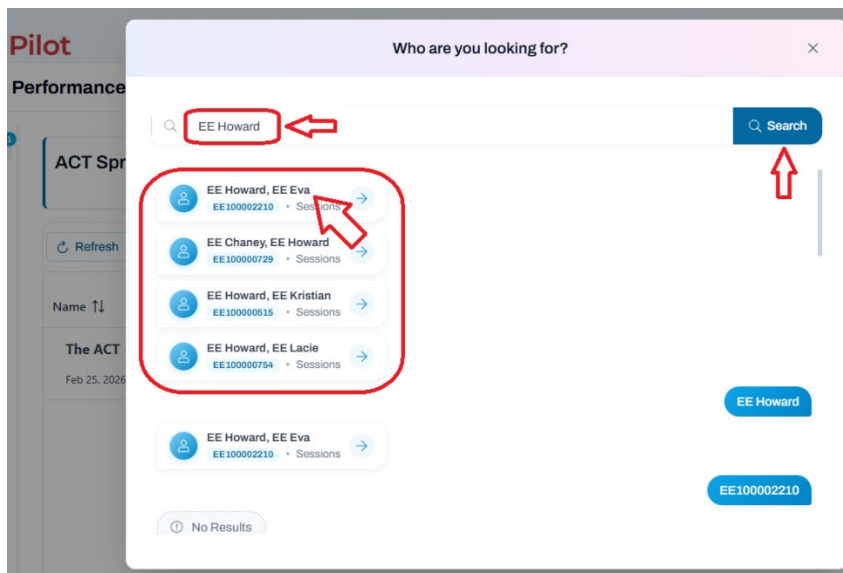


Student Dashboard

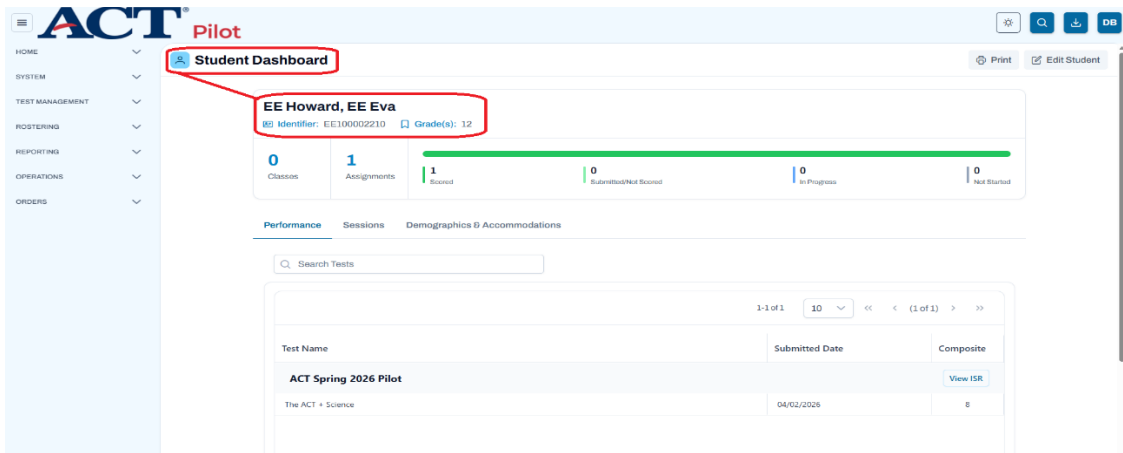
1. To access the Student Dashboard, click on the “Student Search” button in the upper right corner of the screen.



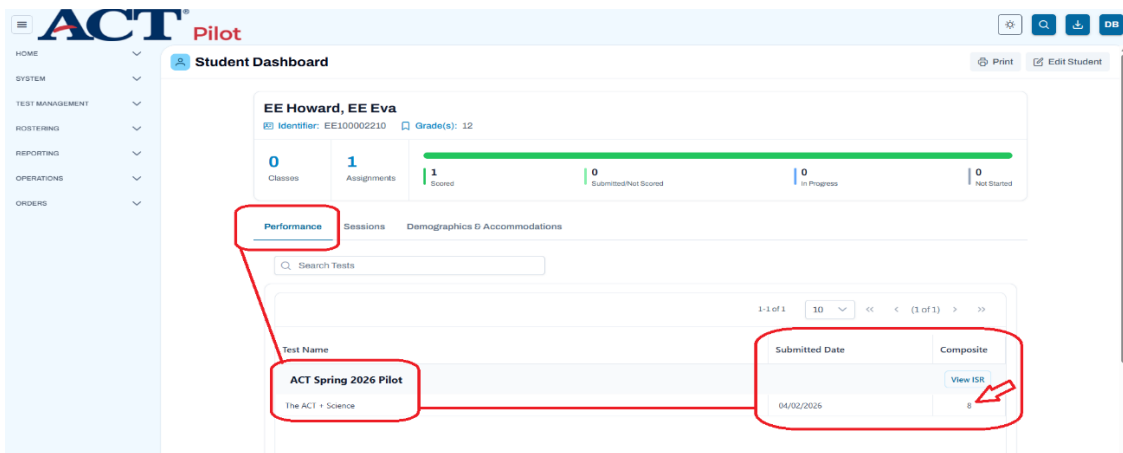
Enter the name of the student for which you would like to view testing results. In this example, we have entered the last name “EE Howard”. Then, click the blue “Search” button on the right. A list of student names that match the search criteria will be displayed. In this example, we are looking for “EE Howard, EE Eva”.



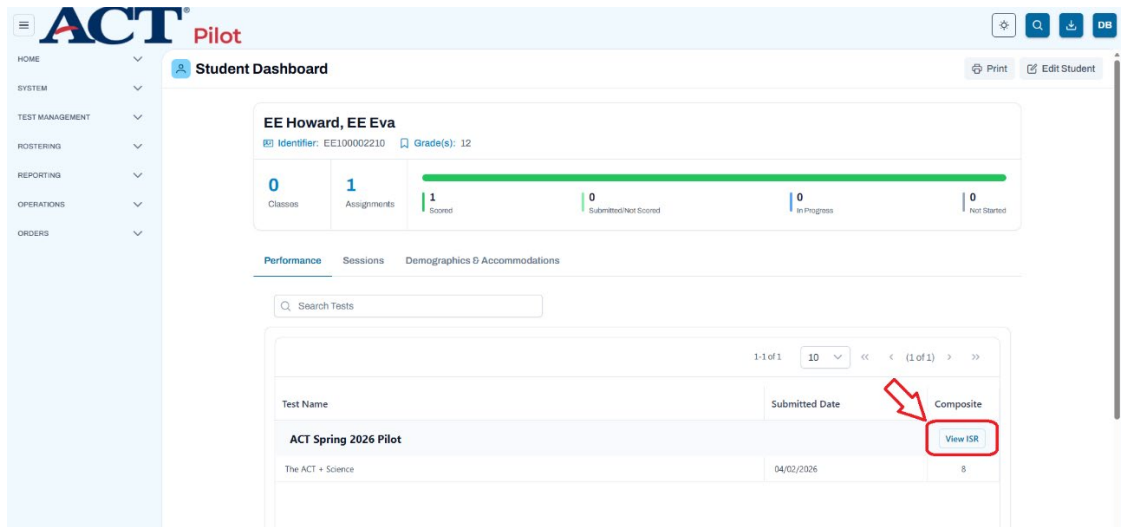
Click on the arrow next to the student's name in the search results list. This will display the Student Dashboard for that student.



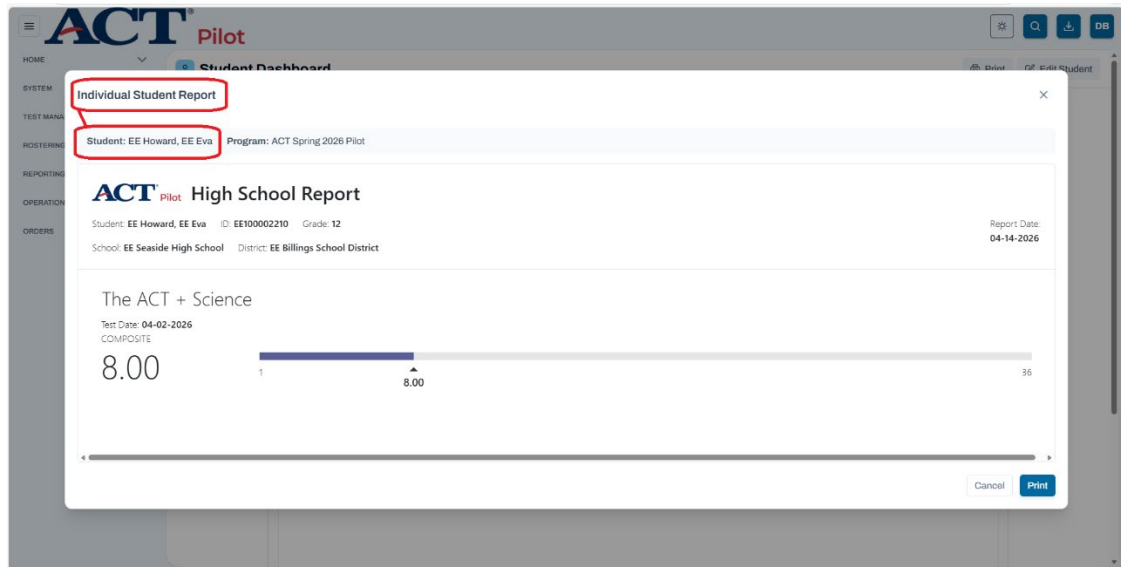
- The student's test results are displayed when the "Performance" option is selected (default). The Student Dashboard will display all tests assigned to the student. In this example, the Composite score for the "The ACT + Science" test is displayed along with the date (e.g. 04/02/2026) when the test was submitted.



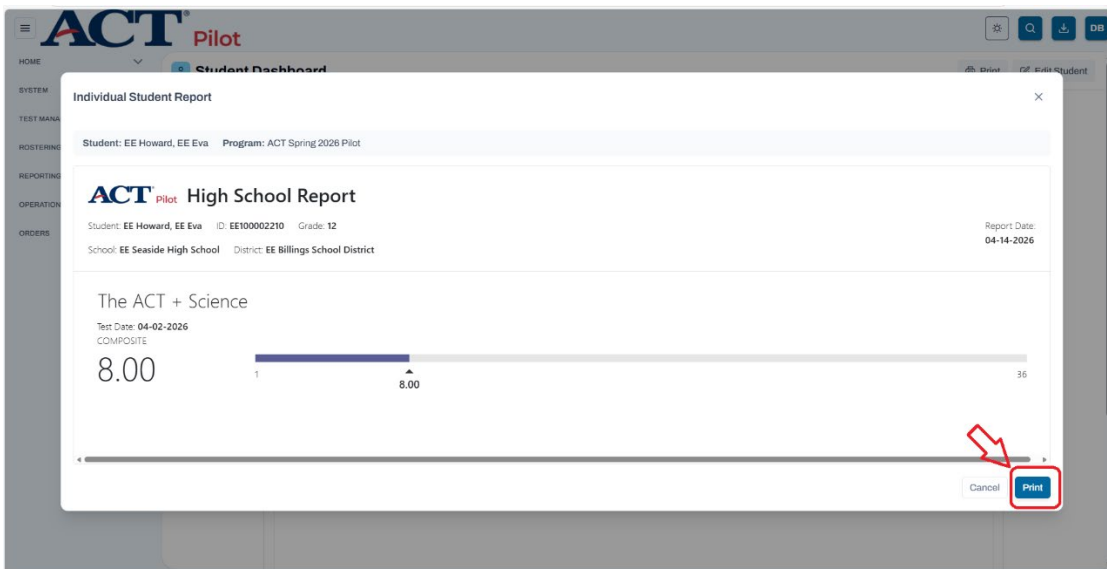
- To view the Individual Student Report (ISR), click the “View ISR” button above the test score for the applicable test.



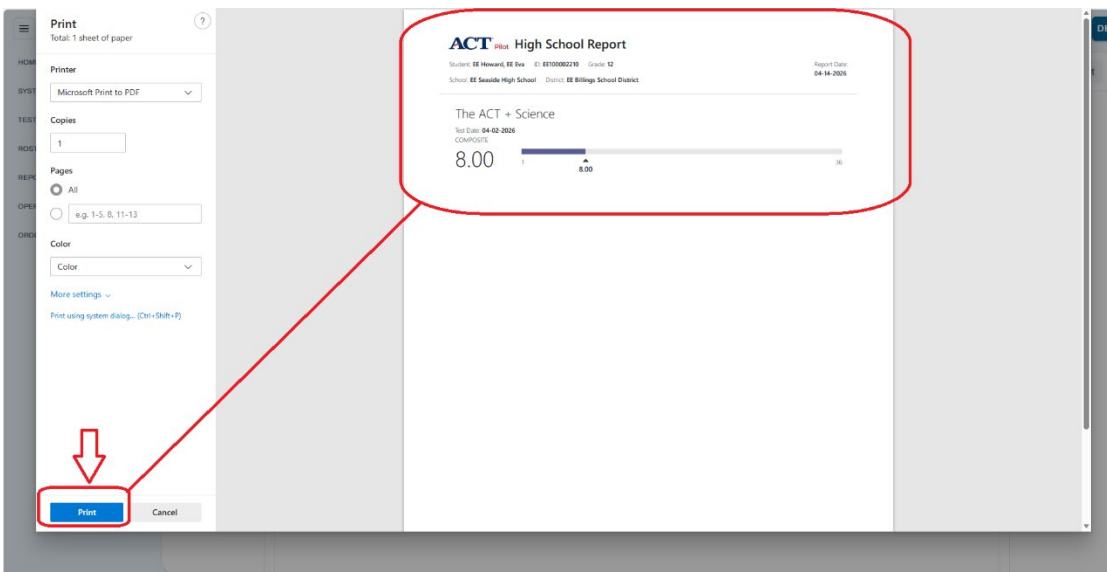
- The “Individual Student Report” for the student will be displayed.



Click the “Print” button to print the ISR.



Choose your desired print destination and click the “Print” button in the lower left corner to print the report displayed on the right.



- On the Student Dashboard, you also have the option to print a “Student Performance Summary.” To print the summary, click the “Print” button in the upper right corner of the Student Dashboard.
